AN ACT TO RENUMBER SUBPARAGRAPH (d) TO BE (e) AND TO ADD A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (d) TO SECTION 8978 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT THE VETERANS AFFAIRS OFFICER AND VETERANS AFFAIRS COUNSELOR TO ACT AS A NOTARY PUBLIC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Subparagraph (d) is hereby renumber (e) and a new Subparagraph (d) is hereby added to Section 8978 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"(d) May administer and certify oaths and affirmations, take and certify affidavits and acknowledgments, and exercise any other power of a notary public, but only as part of his duties under the provisions of this Chapter to assist veterans, their dependents and their survivors, for which services, there shall be no fee charged or collected;"
