



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO RENUMBER SUBPARAGRAPH (d) TO BE
(e) AND TO ADD A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (d) TO
SECTION 8978 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
TO PERMIT THE VETERANS AFFAIRS OFFICER AND
VETERANS AFFAIRS COUNSELOR TO ACT AS A NOTARY
PUBLIC.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (d) is hereby renumber (e) and a
3 new Subparagraph (d) is hereby added to Section 8978 of the
4 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

5 "(d) May administer and certify oaths and affirm-
6 ations, take and certify affidavits and acknowledgments,
7 and exercise any other power of a notary public, but
8 only as part of his duties under the provisions of
9 this Chapter to assist veterans, their dependents and
10 their survivors, for which services, there shall be
11 no fee charged or collected;"
