



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 23319.2 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE A RANKING OF LICENSE
NUMBERS TO BE ISSUED FOR VEHICLES OWNED BY
CERTAIN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23319.2 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 23319.2. In carrying out the issuance of
5 license plates pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter,
6 the Director of Revenue and Taxation shall issue special
7 licenses bearing the following numbers to the following
8 officials of the government of Guam for use on their
9 privately-owned vehicles:

10	Office	Plate Number
11	Governor	1
12	Lieutenant Governor	1-A
13	Speaker	2
14	Vice-Speaker	2-A
15	Legislative Secretary	2-B
16	Senators	2-C through 2-Z
17	District Court Judge	3
18	Island and Police Court Judges	3-A through 3-Z
19	Commissioners	4-A through 4-Z
20	Assistant Commissioners	5-A through 5-Z

21 The foregoing licenses shall be issued to those entitled
22 thereto upon their assumption of the office in question, and

1 where there are more than one person holding any of
2 the foregoing offices, licenses shall be issued in
3 sequence based upon their last names in alphabetical
4 order, except in the case of Island Court Judges who
5 shall be issued licenses in sequence based upon their
6 seniority. Such licenses shall be surrendered to the
7 Department upon their removal from said office for any
8 cause. Nothing herein contained shall be construed as
9 authorizing the waiver of the local registration and
10 licensing requirements for such vehicles and their
11 respective owners nor of preventing the issuance of
12 special government of Guam plates to the official
13 government-owned vehicles assigned to any public
14 officer."
