

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (a) OF SECTION
46005 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO
REDUCE THE STANDARD WORKWEEK IN GUAM FOR
PURPOSES OF THE MINIMUM WAGE FROM 48 HOURS
TO 40 HOURS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (a) of Section 46005 of the Govern-
3 ment Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 46005. Maximum hours: split shifts.

5 (a) No employer shall employ any employee in excess
6 of forty (40) hours a week, unless such employee
7 receives compensation for employment in excess of
8 such weekly hours, at a rate not less than one and
9 one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) times the regular rate at which he is
10 employed."
