





AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE  
WASHINGTON DELEGATION ON FEDERAL PROBLEMS  
AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STUDY  
OF GAMBLING.

1           WHEREAS, a number of very serious matters of direct  
2 interest and concern to the people of Guam are now presently  
3 pending before the Congress of the United States and the  
4 major administrative agencies in our Nation's Capitol; and

5           WHEREAS, the Eleventh Guam Legislature, pursuant to  
6 Resolution No. 53 adopted on April 5, 1971, established a  
7 special delegation from the Eleventh Guam Legislature to  
8 present in Washington, D. C. the views of the people of Guam  
9 on these major issues and in addition to seek from the Congress  
10 of the United States legislation establishing the Land Claims  
11 Commission requested in Resolution No. 6 adopted by this  
12 Legislature; now therefore

13           BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

14           Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
15 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
16 sum of ~~Fifty Thousand Dollars~~ <sup>(\$50,000)</sup> ~~(\$50,000)~~ to the Washington  
17 Delegation on Federal Problems for the purpose of sending  
18 said delegation to Washington, D. C. to express the views and  
19 opinions of the people of Guam upon the various pressing  
20 territorial matters now pending in Washington.

21           Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
22 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
23 sum of ~~Two Hundred Thousand Dollars~~ <sup>Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000)</sup> ~~(\$200,000)~~ to the Washington  
24 Delegation on Federal Problems for the purpose of providing the

1 delegation with such assistance as may be necessary for the  
2 establishment of a Land Claims Commission for Guam, such monies  
3 to be expended only upon resolution by the Guam Legislature as  
4 a whole.

5 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
6 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
7 sum of <sup>Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000)</sup> ~~Thirty-Five-Thousand-Dollars-(\$35,000)~~ to the Select  
8 Committee on Gambling for traveling and other miscellaneous  
9 expenses relating to the study of gambling in various parts  
10 of the world.
