



AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE ON RECREATION AND YOUTH; TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1972; TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 30, 1971, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) to supplement the
5 appropriation made by Public Law 11-35, Eleventh Guam
6 Legislature, for the summer employment under the direction of
7 the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth.

8 Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this
9 Act shall take effect July 1, 1971.

10 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any
11 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
12 Fund, the following sums for the operation of the Executive
13 Branch of the government of Guam for fiscal year ending June
14 30, 1972:
