



AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 54002.1 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT  
AUDITING AND ACCOUNTING EXPERIENCE  
TO MEET EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS OF  
A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT, AND TO  
TO AMEND SECTION 5 OF PUBLIC LAW 11-72,  
ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, RELATIVE TO  
RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS ON SCHOLARSHIPS  
AND STUDENT LOANS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 54002.1 is hereby added to the  
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 54002.1. Government Employment Experience.

5 The Territorial Board of Accountancy may accept, in  
6 fulfillment the requirements of Subparagraphs (1), (2),  
7 (3) and (4) of Paragraph (e) of Section 54002 of this  
8 Chapter, on the same level of experience, year for year,  
9 or portion thereof, employment as an auditor or accountant  
10 with the Federal or Territorial government or an agency  
11 or instrumentality thereof."

12 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law 11-72 is hereby  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 5. For purposes of appropriations made herein  
15 by Section 1., VIII., B., 5., a., b., c., and hereafter  
16 enacted for all government of Guam scholarships and loan  
17 programs, no person who has not been a U. S. citizen and a  
18 bona fide resident of Guam for at least five years prior  
19 to the first day of September of the academic year for  
20 which he/she is applying for loan or scholarship shall be

1 eligible for said loan or scholarship. To be eligible for  
2 scholarship awards, valedictorians and salutatorians and  
3 other graduating high school students shall have been  
4 bona fide residents of Guam for five years as prescribed  
5 in this section above, and shall have taken all their  
6 high school education in Guam."
