




AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4103 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE RATE OF PAY SET
FORTH IN THE PAY RANGE SCHEDULE AND MAKING AN
APPROPRIATION THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The pay range schedule set forth on Section
3 4103 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended by adding
4 the figure "312" to each step and each pay range.

5 Section 2. The increase made by Section 1 of this Act
6 shall be effective on the second pay period after the approval
7 of the Governor.

8 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
9 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
10 following sums for the purposes set forth in Sections 1 and 2
11 of this Act:

8 Section 4. The pay range schedule set out in Section 4103
9 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended by adding the
10 figure "312" to each step and each pay range.

11 Section 5. The increase made by Section 4 of this Act shall
12 take effect July 1, 1972.

13 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available
14 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
15 of Seventy-Six Thousand, One Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars
16 (\$76,138) for contribution to the Retirement Fund.

17 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available
18 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
19 of One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$115,000) for Public
20 Assistance.

21 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available
22 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
23 of Fourteen Thousand, One Hundred Four Dollars (\$14,104) for
24 further study of the star-fish.

25 ~~Section 9. Section 1 of Public Law 11-3 is hereby amended~~
