AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4103 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE RATE OF PAY SET FORTH IN THE PAY RANGE SCHEDULE AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The pay range schedule set forth on Section 4103 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended by adding the figure "312" to each step and each pay range.

Section 2. The increase made by Section 1 of this Act shall be effective on the second pay period after the approval of the Governor.
