
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE CIVIL SERVICE
COMMISSION TO RECLASSIFY THOSE PERSONS
EMPLOYED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM AS
REFUSE COLLECTORS AND TO INCREASE THEIR
PAY RANGE AND TO INCREASE THE PAY RANGE
OF BUS DRIVERS, AND AUTHORIZING AN APPRO-
PRIATION THEREFOR.

1 WHEREAS, although under the provisions of Title V, Chapters
2 I and II of the Government Code of Guam, the Guam Legislature
3 has delegated to a Civil Service Commission authority to classify
4 persons employed by the government of Guam and to establish pay
5 ranges for such classifications as are established, the Eleventh
6 Guam Legislature recognizes that it is beyond the constitutional
7 competence of the Legislature to permanently delegate its law-
8 making authority concerning persons employed by the government of
9 Guam; and now therefore

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Title V of the
12 Government Code of Guam to the contrary, the Civil Service
13 Commission shall redesignate the position title of Refuse
14 Collector to Solid Waste Technician and reclassify the pay
15 range as follows:

4 Section 2. Notwithstanding any provision of Title V of the
5 Government Code of Guam to the contrary, the Civil Service
6 Commission shall reclassify the pay range of Bus Drivers (School)
7 as follows:

9 <u>Code Number</u>	<u>Position Title</u>	<u>Pay Range</u>
10 9.608	Bus Driver (School)	14

11 Section 3. Notwithstanding any provisions of Title V of
12 the Government Code of Guam to the contrary, the reclassification
13 set forth in Section 1 and Section 2 of this Act shall be
14 effective upon the effective date of this Act.

15 Section 4. All laws which are unavoidably inconsistent with
16 this Act are repealed only to the extent of such unavoidable
17 inconsistency, and all executive actions which are unavoidably
18 inconsistent with this Act are superseded only to the extent of
19 such unavoidable inconsistency.

20 Section 5. Nothing in this Act shall preclude the Civil
21 Service Commission from maintaining or reassigning the pay ranges
22 of employees assigned pay ranges pursuant to this Act; provided,
23 however, that such pay ranges shall not be reduced below those
24 established by this Act.

25 Section 6. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
26 such sums as may be necessary to implement the provisions of
27 this Act.
