AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE ESTATE OF JOSEPH C. BORJA.

WHEREAS, Mr. Joseph C. Borja, a para-professional employee at Dededo Junior High School was shot and killed on May 14, 1971, while carrying out his duties as an employee of Dededo Junior High School and of the government of Guam; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Borja as a para-professional employee was not entitled to benefits generally extended to employees of the government of Guam pursuant to Title V of the Government Code of Guam; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of this Eleventh Guam Legislature that an employee of the government of Guam who is killed while performing his duties as an employee should receive benefits despite the absence of a Code provision providing therefor, it being the sense of this Legislature that no man should be required to risk his life for and on behalf of the government without some benefits inuring to his family in the event of his death; now therefore

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to the estate of Joseph C. Borja.
