



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR


This is to certify that Bill No. 505, "An Act making an appropriation to the estate of Joseph C. Borja", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on August 27, 1971, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 4th day of October, 1971, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 15 members.

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE
ESTATE OF JOSEPH C. BORJA.

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Joseph C. Borja, a para-professional employee
2 at Dededo Junior High School was shot and killed on May 14,
3 1971, while carrying out his duties as an employee of Dededo
4 Junior High School and of the government of Guam; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Borja as a para-professional employee was
6 not entitled to benefits generally extended to employees of the
7 government of Guam pursuant to Title V of the Government Code
8 of Guam; and

9 WHEREAS, it is the consensus of this Eleventh Guam
10 Legislature that an employee of the government of Guam who is
11 killed while performing his duties as an employee should
12 receive benefits despite the absence of a Code provision pro-
13 viding therefor, it being the sense of this Legislature that
14 no man should be required to risk his life for and on behalf
15 of the government without some benefits inuring to his family
16 in the event of his death; now therefore

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

18 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
19 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
20 sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to the estate of
21 Joseph C. Borja.
