






AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4106 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
POSITIONS IN THE UNCLASSIFIED SERVICES
AND AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4106 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4106. Unclassified service. The positions
5 set forth herein shall constitute the unclassified
6 service and are hereby given basic annual compensation
7 as follows:

2 Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
3 such sums as may be necessary to implement the provisions of
4 this Act.

5 Section 3. This Act shall be effective at the commencement
6 of the second full pay period after approval by the Governor.
