AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 37006 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO ALLOW COMPENSATION FROM THE DATE OF DISABILITY IF THE DISABILITY IS SUPPORTED BY A PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 37006 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

"(a) No compensation shall be allowed for the first seven (7) days of the disability, except for the benefits provided for in Section 37007; provided, however, that compensation shall be allowed from the date of the disability if the injury results in disability of more than forty-nine (49) days, or if the fact and date of disability is supported by a physician's certificate."
