




AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SUBSECTION (a)
OF SECTION 37006 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF
GUAM TO ALLOW COMPENSATION FROM THE DATE OF
DISABILITY IF THE DISABILITY IS SUPPORTED
BY A PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 37006 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby repealed and reenacted to
4 read as follows:

5 "(a) No compensation shall be allowed for the
6 first seven (7) days of the disability, except for
7 the benefits provided for in Section 37007; provided,
8 however, that compensation shall be allowed from the
9 date of the disability if the injury results in
10 disability of more than forty-nine (49) days, or if
11 the fact and date of disability is supported by a
12 physician's certificate."
