



AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE
TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND FOR VARIOUS
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated
3 from any available funds of the Tourist Attraction Fund for
4 various capital improvements as set forth herewith.

5 A. Improvement of Two Lovers Point

6 (Puntan Dos Amantes) \$53,000.00

7 B. Ipan Beach 45,200.00

8 C. Tagachang Beach 52,000.00

9 D. Fort Santa Agueda (Apugan) 35,800.00

10 E. Pago Bay Overlook 5,300.00

11 F. Cetti Bay Overlook 11,075.00

12 G. Nuestra Senora de la Soledad 28,600.00

13 H. Laderan Tumon Overlook 17,000.00

14 I. Asan Point Overlook 14,500.00

15 J. Improvement of the Agana Boat Basin 100,000.00

1 Section 2. No expenditures shall be charged under Section
2 1(j) of this Act unless the vouchers for such expenditures are
3 accompanied by a certificate executed by the Director of
4 Commerce, verifying that such expenditures are for improvements
5 which substantially conform to the improvement plan recommended
6 by the Study Committee for Action on the Agana Boat Basin, as
7 contained in said Committee's report of October 18, 1971.
