AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11822 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXTEND THE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR VIETNAM WAR ORPHANS TO ORPHANS OF VETERANS OF THE KOREAN WAR, AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 9 TO PUBLIC LAW 11-72, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATION TO THE ISLAND COURT OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11831 of the Government Code of Guam, as added thereto by Public Law 8-190, Eighth Guam Legislature, is hereby renumbered Section 11822 and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 11822. Students entitled to scholarship: amount of scholarship. There are hereby established scholarships to the University of Guam, to include text-books, tuition, room and board, and other school fees, for a period of four (4) years, for each student (one of whose parents is or, at the time of death, was a bona fide resident of the territory of Guam) whose father was a member of the United States Armed Forces killed in the Korean War or the Vietnam conflict. To be eligible for consideration for the scholarships granted under this Subchapter, a student rust be a U.S. citizen and must have

Section 7. The appropriations made by Section 6 of this Act shall be effective July 1, 1972.

Section 8. The Community Action Agency is hereby authorized to spend, over and above the appropriation made by this Act, additional Federal Grants received for approved projects, provided that no local funds are required.

established his residence in the territory of Guam for a period of at least two (2) years immediately preceding his application, and must be otherwise eligible for admission to the University of Guam."

Section 2. Section 9 is hereby added to Public Law 11-72, Eleventh Guam Legislature, to read as follows:

"Section 9. The Island Court of Guam is hereby authorized to transfer appropriations made pursuant to Section 6 of this Act from any allotment number to another allotment number not in excess of ten per cent (10%)."
