
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Bill No. 112, "An Act to amend Section 11822 of the Government Code of Guam to extend the scholarships for Vietnam War orphans to orphans of veterans of the Korean War, and to add a new Section 9 to Public Law 11-72, Eleventh Guam Legislature, relative to appropriation to the Island Court of Guam", which was heretofore passed and thereafter on December 1, 1971, returned to the Legislature without the approval of the Governor was in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration the Legislature did on the 16th day of December, 1971, agree to pass said bill notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of more than two-thirds of all the members thereof, to wit: by a vote of 17 members.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11822 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXTEND THE
SCHOLARSHIPS FOR VIETNAM WAR ORPHANS TO
ORPHANS OF VETERANS OF THE KOREAN WAR,
AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 9 TO PUBLIC
LAW 11-72, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE,
RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATION TO THE ISLAND
COURT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11831 of the Government Code of Guam, as
3 added thereto by Public Law 8-190, Eighth Guam Legislature, is
4 hereby renumbered Section 11822 and is hereby amended to read
5 as follows:

6 "Section 11822. Students entitled to scholarship:
7 amount of scholarship. There are hereby established
8 scholarships to the University of Guam, to include text-
9 books, tuition, room and board, and other school fees,
10 for a period of four (4) years, for each student (one of
11 whose parents is or, at the time of death, was a bona
12 fide resident of the territory of Guam) whose father was
13 a member of the United States Armed Forces killed in the
14 Korean War or the Vietnam conflict. To be eligible for
15 consideration for the scholarships granted under this
16 Subchapter, a student must be a U.S. citizen and must have

8 Section 5. The appropriations made by Section 4 of this
9 Act shall be effective January 1, 1972.

10 Section 6. The following sums are hereby appropriated
11 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
12 General Fund for the operation of the Community Action Agency
13 to supplement the appropriation made by Section 4 of this Act
14 for Calendar Year ending December 31, 1972.

23 Section 7. The appropriations made by Section 6 of this
24 Act shall be effective July 1, 1972.

25 Section 8. The Community Action Agency is hereby
26 authorized to spend, over and above the appropriation made by
27 this Act, additional Federal Grants received for approved
28 projects, provided that no local funds are required.

5 Section 2. Section 9 is hereby added to Public Law 11-72,
6 Eleventh Guam Legislature, to read as follows:

7 "Section 9. The Island Court of Guam is hereby autho-
8 rized to transfer appropriations made pursuant to Section
9 6 of this Act from any allotment number to another
10 allotment number not in excess of ten per cent (10%)."
