


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4106 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE BASIC ANNUAL COMPENSATION OF THE JUDGE OF THE POLICE COURT OF GUAM AND TO AMEND SECTION 121 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE TO INCLUDE THE JUDGE OF THE POLICE COURT AS A MEMBER OF THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4106 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby amended, where pertinent, to read as follows:

4 "Judge of the Police Court Statutory 19,000"

5 Section 2. Section 121 of the Code of Civil Procedure is
6 hereby amended to read as follows:

7 "Section 121. Composition. There shall be a
8 Judicial Council of Guam, which shall consist of the
9 Judge of the District Court of Guam, the Chief Judge
10 and judges of the Island Court, the judge of the Police
11 Court, the Chairman of the Committee on Judiciary of the
12 Legislature, the Attorney General of Guam, and the pre-
13 sident of the Bar Association of Guam. The concurrence
14 of a majority of the members shall be necessary to any
15 action taken by the Judicial Council. The Judicial
16 Council annually shall elect a chairman and a vice-
17 chairman from among its members and a secretary who
18 shall not be a member of the Judicial Council. No
19 member or officer of the Judicial Council, except the
20 secretary, shall receive any compensation as such."

21 Section 3. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
22 such sums as may be necessary to implement the pay increase
23 provided for by this Act.

24 Section 4. The pay increase provided for by this Act shall
25 be effective at the commencement of the second full pay period
26 after approval by the Governor.
