



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD SECTIONS 228, 228.1, AND  
228.2 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO  
DESIGNATE THE THIRD WEEK OF APRIL AS  
EARTH WEEK AND TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR  
TO APPOINT AN EARTH WEEK COMMITTEE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Sections 228, 228.1, and 228.2 are hereby added  
3 to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 228. Earth Week. The third week in April of  
5 each year is hereby designated as 'Earth Week', a week to  
6 review and assess environmental progress and to determine  
7 what further steps must be taken, to continue an island-  
8 wide effort of education on environmental problems, and to  
9 renew the commitment of each citizen to restoring and  
10 protecting the quality of Guam's environment.

11 Section 228.1. Same: proclamation. The Governor of  
12 Guam shall issue annually a proclamation calling upon all  
13 interests, including education, agriculture, business,  
14 labor, government, civic and private organizations, and  
15 individuals, to observe Earth Week by joining together for



1 a continuing commitment, and in a cooperative effort, to  
2 preserve the integrity and livability of Guam's environ-  
3 ment.

4 Section 228.2. Same: Earth Week Committee. The  
5 Governor is hereby authorized to appoint an Earth Week  
6 Committee to plan and make appropriate arrangements for  
7 the observation of Earth Week. Said Committee shall be  
8 composed of members of civic organizations which concern  
9 themselves with preserving the integrity and livability  
10 of Guam's environment."
