AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 11-87 TO REDUCE THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE YOUTH CENTER'S PROGRAM UNDER THE GUAM YOUTH AND RECREATION COMMISSION AND TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR YOUTH DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 11-87 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ninety-Nine Thousand One Hundred and Thirty-Four Dollars (\$99,134) for the operation of the youth center's program under the Guam Youth and Recreation Commission."

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500) for the operation of Youth Day 1972.

Section 3. All proceeds collected from activities during Youth Day 1972 may be expended for the operation of Youth Day 1972.

Section 4. The Central Planning Committee of Youth Day 1972 shall submit to the Guam Legislature and the Governor of Guam a full report of the Youth Day activities including, a detailed analysis of all incomes received and expenditures made for the operation of Youth Day 1972, on or before June 1, 1972.
