



AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (a) OF SECTION  
18400 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO  
REQUIRE SIDEWALKS IN URBAN AREAS WITHIN  
SUBDIVISIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (a) of Section 18400 of the  
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(a) Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks - Urban areas.

5 Where general plans have been or are hereafter duly adopted  
6 and show an area as planned for development into urban use,  
7 the following street, alley and sidewalk improvements shall  
8 be required:

9 All streets and alleys within the subdivision shall be  
10 graded and drained the full width of the right-of-way. The  
11 roadbed portion of the right-of-way shall be improved with  
12 a stablized coral base and surfaced with light bituminous  
13 surface treatment having a minimum width of twenty-two feet

1 (22'). The roadway centerline gradient and right-of-way  
2 cross-section including drainage ditches, travelled  
3 roadway design and paving and shoulders shall be in  
4 conformity to criteria established by the Commission.

5 Permanent sidewalks having a minimum width of four  
6 feet (4') shall be laid out for all streets and shall be  
7 dedicated to the government of Guam. The Commission shall  
8 establish criteria relating to width and construction of  
9 such sidewalks, and all such sidewalks shall be in con-  
10 formity thereto".
