AN ACT TO RETURN THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE OF CERTAIN CAPITAL PROJECT ACCOUNTS TO THE UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS OF THE CENERAL FUND AND MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The unencumbered balances as of January 31, 1972, of the following project accounts are hereby returned to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purchase of equipment for the Vocational Technical Food Service Training Facility.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$52,700.00) to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purchase and installation of a Waste Water Disposal at Yona Elementary School.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for the operation of the

Guam Educational Telecommunications Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for the construction of bus shelters.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for the purchase and installation of waterlines for the Escubella residents in Yona.

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to provide a four inch (4") waterline for the residents of lower Maite.

Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to supplement Public Law 11-43, Eleventh Guam Legislature, providing waterlines between Umatac and Agat.

Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth for the purpose of providing summer employment for students of the various public and private schools in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years of age, such students to be employed during the summer period, between school terms by the government of Guam for assignment

approved by the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth.

Students employed under this program shall receive Workmen's

Compensation, but shall not be eligible for any of the

retirement, sick leave, or annual leave benefits applicable

to regular employees of the government or private enterprise,

except as may be specifically provided.

The government shall be responsible for paying such

students at the rate of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per

The government shall be responsible for paying such students at the rate of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per hour. The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall be reimbursed by the private business to which said students are assigned the sum of Seventy-Five Cents (\$.75) for every One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) paid to such students.

The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this section.

Section 11. Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) of the appropriation made by Section 10 of this Act shall take effect upon approval thereof.

Section 12. One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$175,000) of the appropriation made by Section 10 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 1972.

Section 13. Thirty (30) days after the completion of the Summer Youth Employment Program, the Governor of Guam shall submit to the Guam Legislature a report on the implementation of the provisions of Section 10 of this Act including the costs related thereto.

Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the zero (0) (2), sum of Fifty-Thousand-Dollars-(\$50,000) to implement Public Law 11-44, Eleventh Guam Legislature, authorizing the subdivision of an unsurveyed government property at Maimai in

the municipalities of timejana and Chilan Pago-Ordat and the sale of lots therein at less than fair market value and setting un priorities of such sales. Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum

of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) to implement Resolution No. 517 for road construction in the Talisay Subdivision in Agat.

Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to pave the parking area at Nimitz Beach and the entrance road from Marine Drive in and out of the Nimitz Beach parking area and to install curbs along both sides of said entrance road.

Section 17. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist Attraction Fund the sum of Twenty-Pive Thousand Dollars - (\$25,000) for the purchase and installation of day beacons, night lightings, entrance and on-shore markers, and buoys at the Merizo Cocos Island and Mamaon Channels in Merizo.

Section 18. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) for the development of a public tennis center in Agana Park on the handball court adjacent to the new pool, such funds to be used for the purchase and construction of posts and nets, lights, line markings, and fences around the public tennis center.

Section 19. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One-Thousand-Five-Hundred-Dollars-(\$1,500.00) for street lighting facilities in the Hyundai Subdivision in Mongmong.

Section 20. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum

of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$45,000) for the installation of waterlines in the Mataguac area in Yigo.

Section 21. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the installation of waterlines in that area in Yigo near the Andersen front gate and to use any surplus funds to make the waterline connections for those people without water.
