AN ACT TO RETURN THE UNENCUMBERED BALANCE
OF CERTAIN CAPITAL PROJECT ACCOUNTS TO THE
UNAPPROPRIATED SURPLUS OF THE GENERAL FUND
AND MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The unencumbered balances as of January 31,
3 1972, of the following project accounts are hereby returned
4 to the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund:

11 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
12 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
13 of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purchase of
14 equipment for the Vocational Technical Food Service Training
15 Facility.

16 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
17 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
18 of Fifty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$52,700.00) to the
19 Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purchase and installation
20 of a Waste Water Disposal at Yona Elementary School.

21 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available
22 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
23 of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for the operation of the

1 Guam Educational Telecommunications Commission for the fiscal
2 year ending June 30, 1972.

3 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available
4 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
5 of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for the construction of
6 bus shelters.

7 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available
8 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
9 of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for the purchase and
10 installation of waterlines for the Escubella residents in Yona.

11 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available
12 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
13 of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to provide a four inch (4")
14 waterline for the residents of lower Maite.

15 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available
16 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
17 of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) to supplement Public Law
18 11-43, Eleventh Guam Legislature, providing waterlines between
19 Umatac and Agat.

20 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available
21 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
22 sum of Ten ^{zero} Thousand ⁽⁰⁾ Dollars ~~(\$10,000)~~ for the purpose of
23 lighting and repairing the basketball facilities at Ordot-
24 Chalan Pago.

25 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available
26 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
27 of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to the
28 Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth for the purpose of
29 providing summer employment for students of the various public
30 and private schools in Guam who are at least sixteen (16) years
31 of age, such students to be employed during the summer period,
32 between school terms by the government of Guam for assignment

1 to government agencies or departments or to private businesses
2 approved by the Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth.
3 Students employed under this program shall receive Workmen's
4 Compensation, but shall not be eligible for any of the
5 retirement, sick leave, or annual leave benefits applicable
6 to regular employees of the government or private enterprise,
7 except as may be specifically provided.

8 The government shall be responsible for paying such
9 students at the rate of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per
10 hour. The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall be
11 reimbursed by the private business to which said students are
12 assigned the sum of Seventy-Five Cents (\$.75) for every One
13 Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) paid to such students.

14 The Governor's Committee on Recreation and Youth shall
15 make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry
16 out the purposes of this section.

17 Section 11. Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) of
18 the appropriation made by Section 10 of this Act shall take
19 effect upon approval thereof.

20 Section 12. One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars
21 (\$175,000) of the appropriation made by Section 10 of this Act
22 shall take effect July 1, 1972.

23 Section 13. Thirty (30) days after the completion of the
24 Summer Youth Employment Program, the Governor of Guam shall
25 submit to the Guam Legislature a report on the implementation
26 of the provisions of Section 10 of this Act including the costs
27 related thereto.

28 Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any available
29 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
30 sum of Fifty-Thousand-Dollars-^{zero} (~~\$50,000~~)⁽⁰⁾ to implement Public
31 Law 11-44, Eleventh Guam Legislature, authorizing the sub-
32 division of an unsurveyed government property at Maimai in

1 the municipalities of Sindangan and Chalan Bago-ombot and the
2 sale of lots therein at less than fair market value and setting
3 up priorities of such sales.

4 Section 15. There is hereby appropriated from any available
5 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
6 of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000) to implement Resolution
7 No. 517 for road construction in the Talisay Subdivision in Agat.

8 Section 16. There is hereby appropriated from any available
9 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
10 of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to pave the
11 parking area at Nimitz Beach and the entrance road from
12 Marine Drive in and out of the Nimitz Beach parking area and
13 to install curbs along both sides of said entrance road.

14 Section 17. There is hereby appropriated from any available
15 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist Attraction
16 Fund the sum of ^{zero} ~~Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars~~ ⁽⁰⁾ ~~(\$25,000)~~ for the
17 purchase and installation of day beacons, night lightings,
18 entrance and on-shore markers, and buoys at the Merizo Cocos
19 Island and Mamaon Channels in Merizo.

20 Section 18. There is hereby appropriated from any available
21 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
22 of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) for the development of
23 a public tennis center in Agana Park on the handball court
24 adjacent to the new pool, such funds to be used for the purchase
25 and construction of posts and nets, lights, line markings, and
26 fences around the public tennis center.

27 Section 19. There is hereby appropriated from any available
28 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
29 of ^{zero} ~~One-Thousand-Five-Hundred-Dollars~~ ⁽⁰⁾ ~~(\$1,500.00)~~ for street
30 lighting facilities in the Hyundai Subdivision in Mongmong.

31 Section 20. There is hereby appropriated from any available
32 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum

1 of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) for the installation of
2 waterlines in the Mataguac area in Yigo.

3 Section 21. There is hereby appropriated from any available
4 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum
5 of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) for the installation of
6 waterlines in that area in Yigo near the Andersen front gate
7 and to use any surplus funds to make the waterline connections
8 for those people without water.
