

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 13404.1 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO NAME THE PUBLIC
PARK ON ROUTE 2 IN UMATAC THE "MEMORIAS
PARA Y LALAHITA PARK".

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13404.1 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 13404.1. Memorias Para Y Lalahita Park.

5 The Legislature finding that the Guam Women's Club
6 recently completed a worthy project by erecting appro-
7 priate walls and monuments at the Park on Route 2,
8 approximately one mile from the village proper of Umatac
9 overlooking the beautiful Umatac Valley, Umatac Bay and
10 Umatac Village and that the Guam Women's Club desires that
11 said park be named and dedicated the 'Memorias Para Y
12 Lalahita Park' in memory of the sons of Guam who lost
13 their life, in World War I, World War II, and the Korean
14 and Vietnam Conflicts, said public park area in the
15 municipality of Umatac is hereby named the 'Memorias

1 Para Y Lalahita Park' and the Director of Land Management
2 shall, at such ceremony as he deems appropriate, cause
3 an appropriate sign to be erected designating and
4 dedicating such park."
