

AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 11-72
BY ADDING SECTION 9 RELATIVE TO
AUTHORIZATION TO EXPEND FEDERAL
GRANTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Public Law 11-72 is hereby amended by adding
