

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (a) OF  
SECTION 374 OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM  
RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING LITTERING.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (a) of Section 374 of the Penal  
3 Code of Guam is hereby amended as follows:

4 "Section 374. Proscription of litter in public  
5 places. (a) No person shall place, dispose, throw, or  
6 permit to be deposited or scattered, any waste, refuse,  
7 litter, or foreign substance in or upon any highway,  
8 street or other public passageway or upon any beach, public  
9 park, or other public property, except public dumps  
10 authorized by the Director of Public Works."
