

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 397a OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM TO LOWER THE AGE LIMITS ON PLAYING POOL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 397a of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 397a. Poolrooms. Every person operating a poolroom who employs any person under 16 years of age in such poolroom, or who knowingly allows any person under 16 years of age to visit or remain in such poolroom, shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than \$100."
