



Introduced by G. M. Bamba

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 397a OF THE  
PENAL CODE OF GUAM TO LOWER THE AGE  
LIMITS ON PLAYING POOL.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 397a of the Penal Code of Guam is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 397a. Poolrooms. Every person operating  
5 a poolroom who employs any person under 16 years of age  
6 in such poolroom, or who knowingly allows any person  
7 under 16 years of age to visit or remain in such  
8 poolroom, shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more  
9 than \$100."
