AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 19543.1011 AND TO RENUMBER SECTION 19543.1012 TO 19543.1011 AND TO AMEND SECTION 19541.05, ALL OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO GROSS RECEIPTS TAX ON CONTRACTORS UNDER TITLE VIII, "MILITARY HOUSING INSURANCE; OF THE NATIONAL HOUSING ACT, AS AMENDED".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 19543.1011 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 19543.1012 is hereby renumbered 19543.1011.

Section 3. Section 19541.05 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 19541.05. Tax on Contractors. shall be levied, assessed and collected a tax at the rate of four percent (4%) measured against the gross income of any contractor."

Section 4. The provisions of Section 1 and Section 2 of this Act shall not apply to gross receipts from contracts executed on or before the effective date of this Act, and contractors or subcontractors having executed such contracts shall be entitled to the exemptions allowed under Section 19543.1011 and Subparagraph (b) of Section 19541.05 of the Government Code of Guam prior to the effective date of this Act.
