AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE JUDICIAL BRANCH, GOVERNMENT OF GUAM, AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 6118.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund effective July 1, 1972, the sum of Two Million One Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$2,154,835) for the operation of the Judiciary for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, and for various capital improvements and other purposes.

Section 2. The appropriation made by Section 1 of this Act shall be apportioned as follows:

Fund and shall be considered as having been included within the appropriation made under Section 1 of this Act, and appropriated for the purpose for which received.

Section 4. Section 6118.3 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 6118.3. Transfer Authority: Judicial Branch Appropriations. The Administrative Director of the Courts with the approval of the Judicial Council is hereby authorized to transfer an aggregated of not to exceed five per cent (5%) of any item of appropriation within the annual operational appropriation for the Judicial Branch to any other item of appropriation within that operational appropriation, and to transfer not to exceed five per cent (5%) of any item of appropriation within the annual Capital Improvement appropriation for the Judicial Branch to any other item of appropriation within that Capital Improvement appropriation; provided, however that no item of appropriation shall be increased an aggregate of more than five per cent (5%). The Administrator of the Courts shall submit to the Legislature a quarterly report of all transfers made pursuant to this Section."
