AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH BUREAU FOR THE PERIOD ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1972.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the operation of the Legislative Research Bureau the sum of Forty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred and One Dollars (\$49,201) for the period ending December 31, 1972.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1972.
