CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





Introduced by W. D. L. Flores

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (c) OF
SECTION 4233 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR MEMBERS
OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE TO OBTAIN RE-
TIREMENT CREDIT FOR PRIOR SERVICE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (c) of Section 4233 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(c). Any person who has served as a member of
5 the Legislature or who shall hereafter serve as such
6 a member shall be entitled to receive credit as prior
7 service for all services rendered as a member of the
8 Legislature or in any other department, division, or
9 agency of the government of Guam, or U. S. Government
10 (including the Armed Forces of the United States),
11 provided, that in order to obtain credit for such
12 prior service as a member of the Legislature, a person
13 shall pay before January 1, 1977, an amount equal to
14 one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for each year of
15 service as member of the Legislature during the
16 period of 1951 to 1966."
