AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (c) OF SECTION 4233 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR MEMBERS OF THE GUAM LEGISLATURE TO OBTAIN RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR PRIOR SERVICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraph (c) of Section 4233 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(c). Any person who has served as a member of the Legislature or who shall hereafter serve as such a member shall be entitled to receive credit as prior service for all services rendered as a member of the Legislature or in any other department, division, or agency of the government of Guam, or U. S. Government (including the Armed Forces of the United States), provided, that in order to obtain credit for such prior service as a member of the Legislature, a person shall pay before January 1, 1977, an amount equal to one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for each year of service as member of the Legislature during the period of 1951 to 1966."
