

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF TWO TEMPORARY WARDS AT  
GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND TO SUPPLEMENT  
THE APPROPRIATION MADE BY SECTION 5 OF  
PUBLIC LAW 10-105, TENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE,  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

~~Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000) for the construction  
of two temporary wards at Guam Memorial Hospital.~~

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to supplement the appropria-  
tion made by Section 5 of Public Law 10-105, Tenth Guam Legis-  
lature, to provide an easement for ingress and egress 40 feet in  
width leading from the public right-of-way serving the Department  
of Agriculture Reservation, across the government land set aside  
for the Juvenile Detention Home, to another public right-of-way,  
so as to permit those living across from the Department of  
Agriculture Reservation access to the public highway system,  
such appropriation to be used to relocate the fences of the  
Juvenile Detention Home, and grade the right-of-way to the  
same condition as the public rights of way it connects.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the



1 sum of One Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars  
2 (\$122,500) to supplement the appropriation made by Section 14  
3 of Public Law 10-171, to pay the Guam Combat Patrol Veterans  
4 bonuses authorized by Public Law 10-101, Tenth Guam Legislature.

5 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
6 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
7 sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000) to provide portable  
8 chemical toilets, at the basketball-tennis court in Barrigada.
