AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 4006.1 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND TO REENACT A NEW SECTION 4006.1 TO CREATE MATERNITY LEAVE FOR TEN DAYS IN ADDITION TO SICK LEAVE FOR FEMALE EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4006.1 of the Government Code of

of Guam is hereby repealed and a new Section 4006.1 is hereby
enacted to read as follows:

"Section 4006.1. Maternity leave. Maternity leave shall be granted to a female employee occupying a permanent position who is absent from work because of confinement for childbirth. Such maternity leave shall not exceed ten (10) days, shall be in addition to any accumulated sick leave, and shall be paid leave. Such maternity leave shall be any ten (10) days encompassing the date of childbirth, and any additional leave taken for such childbirth purposes shall be charged against accumulated sick leave."
