



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 4006.1 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND TO REENACT
A NEW SECTION 4006.1 TO CREATE MATERNITY
LEAVE FOR TEN DAYS IN ADDITION TO SICK
LEAVE FOR FEMALE EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERN-
MENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. .Section 4006.1 of the Government Code of
3 of Guam is hereby repealed and a new Section 4006.1 is hereby
4 enacted to read as follows:

5 "Section 4006.1. Maternity leave. Maternity leave
6 shall be granted to a female employee occupying a per-
7 manent position who is absent from work because of con-
8 finement for childbirth. Such maternity leave shall not
9 exceed ten (10) days, shall be in addition to any accumu-
10 lated sick leave, and shall be paid leave. Such maternity
11 leave shall be any ten (10) days encompassing the date of
12 childbirth, and any additional leave taken for such child-
13 birth purposes shall be charged against accumulated sick
14 leave."
