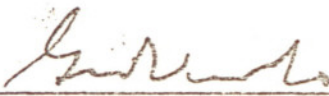
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 20002(c) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE
MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF LOW-COST HOUSING LOAN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 20002(c) of Chapter I, Title XXI,
3 Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(c) To encourage and engage in low-cost housing
5 activities, including development of residential sub-
6 divisions, construction of housing for rental or resale,
7 and to make loans to any person for the purchase, construc-
8 tion, improvement or repair of a home. All loans so made
9 shall be of such sound value or so secured as reasonably
10 to assure repayment, taking into consideration the policy
11 of the Legislature that the lending powers of the Housing
12 Corporation shall be administered as a means for accom-
13 plishing the purposes stated in Section 20000 of this
14 Chapter, and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding
