AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 11-105, ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITION TO THE CENTRAL PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT CENTER IN MANGILAO, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
4 of One Hundred and Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000.00) to  
5 provide for the construction of an addition to the Central  
6 Public Health and Social Services Diagnostic and Treatment  
7 Center in Mangilao pursuant to Public Law 11-105, Eleventh  
8 Guam Legislature.

9 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
10 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
11 sum of Forty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$42,000.00) to supplement  
12 the appropriations made by Public Law 11-8, Eleventh Guam  
13 Legislature, and Section 2 of Public Law 11-108, Eleventh Guam  
14 Legislature, for the construction of a public library building  
15 in the village of Merizo.

16 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
17 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
18 sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) to provide for the  
19 extension of power to the Cruz Subdivision in the municipality  
20 of Agat.

21 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
22 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
23 sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to construct additional  
24 bus shelters in the various districts throughout Guam.



1 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
2 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
3 sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) for the installation  
4 of street lights along Marine Drive in Anigua.

5 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
6 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
7 sum of One Hundred Four Thousand Dollars (\$104,000.00) for the  
8 payment of claims against the government.

9 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
10 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
11 of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) for the in-  
12 stallation of street lights alongside that portion of Route 16,  
13 commencing at the junction of Route 16 and Route 8 in Barrigada  
14 and extending to the entrance of the Harmon Strip.

15 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
16 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
17 of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the installation of  
18 street lights along Marine Drive between Wettengel Junction and  
19 the Layne International Building and along Santa Monica Avenue  
20 from Marine Drive to the Wettengel School in the municipality  
21 of Dededo and in the municipality of Yigo.

22 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
23 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
24 sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for the installation  
25 of twenty-seven (27) additional street lights in the municipality  
26 of Talofoyo.

27 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
28 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
29 of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the installation of  
30 additional street lights in San Antonio-Lalo, Layang, Aspengao,  
31 Canada and Toto areas in the municipality of Barrigada.



1 Section 11. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
2 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
3 sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the construction  
4 of launching ramps for small boats to be located at the  
5 former Old Agat Elementary School site behind the latte stone  
6 sign post installed by the Chamber of Commerce, such launching  
7 ramps to be available for the joint use of the villages of  
8 Agat and Santa Rita.

9 Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
10 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
11 of <sup>Z e r o</sup> ~~Twenty-Five-Thousand-Dollars~~ <sup>(0)</sup> ~~(\$25,000.00)~~ to the Pacific  
12 Conference of Legislators to pay for outstanding accounts payable  
13 by the Pacific Conference of Legislators.

14 Section 13. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
15 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum  
16 of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) to pay the outstanding  
17 printing accounts of the Constitutional Convention.

18 Section 14. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
19 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the  
20 sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) for the con-  
21 struction of a Commissioner's Office in Mongmong.
