



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 26207 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO NAME THE
AGANA HEIGHTS BASEBALL FIELD "PEDRO C.
PANGELINAN BASEBALL FIELD."

1 WHEREAS, on February 23, 1971, Sergeant Pedro C. Pangelinan
2 while attached to Company 13, First Battalion, Seventh Cavalry
3 Division, United States Army, Vietnam was killed while on a
4 combat mission in Vietnam; and

5 WHEREAS, Sergeant Pedro C. Pangelinan of Agana Heights
6 was a well-known sports figure in Guam, having been a star
7 pitcher for Agana Heights and an all around athlete having won
8 several sports awards; and

9 WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Legislature that it
10 would be fitting and appropriate to name the Agana Heights
11 Baseball Field in honor of this deceased hero; now therefore

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

13 Section 1. Section 26207 is hereby added to the Government
14 Code of Guam to read as follows:

1 "Section 26207. Pedro C. Pangelinan Baseball Field.

2 The Agana Heights Baseball Field is hereby named the
3 'Pedro C. Pangelinan Baseball Field' in honor of Sergeant
4 Pedro C. Pangelinan who died on February 23, 1971 in combat
5 in Vietnam. There shall be placed in an appropriate place
6 on the field a plaque so honoring the late Sergeant Pedro
7 C. Pangelinan and the field shall be named by the Governor
8 of Guam in such commemorative ceremony as he deems appro-
9 priate following the approval hereof."
