AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 25108 AND 25121 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR THE CLASS 7, TEMPORARY BEER LICENSE, AND TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF DAYS DURING WHICH A PERSON HOLDING SUCH A LICENSE IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL BEER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 25108 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amend, where appropriate, to read as follows:

"Class 7. Temporary beer license....\$10.00 per day" Section 2. Section 25121 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 25121. Same: temporary beer. A person holding a temporary beer license is authorized to sell beer for consumption on premises temporarily occupied for the purpose of a picnic, special gathering or similar occasions specified by the Board for a period not exceeding six (6) days."
