

Introduced by F. R. Santos

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 25108 AND 25121 OF  
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE THE  
FEE FOR THE CLASS 7, TEMPORARY BEER LICENSE,  
AND TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF DAYS DURING  
WHICH A PERSON HOLDING SUCH A LICENSE IS  
AUTHORIZED TO SELL BEER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 25108 of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amend, where appropriate, to read as follows:

4 "Class 7. Temporary beer license....\$10.00 per day"

5 Section 2. Section 25121 of the Government Code of Guam  
6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

7 "Section 25121. Same: temporary beer. A person  
8 holding a temporary beer license is authorized to sell  
9 beer for consumption on premises temporarily occupied  
10 for the purpose of a picnic, special gathering or  
11 similar occasions specified by the Board for a period  
12 not exceeding six (6) days."
