

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPHS (b) AND  
(c) OF SECTION 680.3 OF THE CODE OF  
CIVIL PROCEDURE AND TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH  
(b) (1) OF SECTION 680.5 OF SAID CODE TO  
PERMIT PERSONS EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE  
TO SERVE ON JURIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraphs (b) and (c) of Section 680.3 of  
3 the Code of Civil Procedure are hereby amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 "(b) Random selection from lists of registered  
6 voters. The Legislature finds that the lists of registered  
7 voters for the last general election in Guam represent  
8 a fair cross-section of the community of Guam.

9 The clerk shall make the random selection of names  
10 as follows: One out of every ten (10) names from such lists  
11 shall be selected by first selecting a starting number,  
12 by chance, between one and ten, and every tenth name  
13 thereafter shall be selected.

14 (c) Master jury wheel. The clerk shall maintain a  
15 master jury wheel for the territory. The names of all  
16 persons randomly selected from the voter registration  
17 lists shall be placed in the master jury wheel. Initially  
18 the master jury wheel shall be filled on or before January



1 1, 1969, with approximately seventeen hundred (1700) names  
2 randomly selected from the 1968 Guam general election  
3 voter registration lists which the Legislature finds  
4 consists of approximately seventeen thousand (17,000)  
5 names. The Chief Judge may order additional names to be  
6 placed in the master jury wheel from time to time, as  
7 required. The master jury wheel shall be emptied and  
8 refilled between November 1, and January 1 of every fourt  
9 year thereafter."

10 Section 2. Subparagraph (b) (1) of Section 680.5 of the  
11 Code of Civil Procedure is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "(b) In making such determination the Chief Judge  
13 shall deem any person qualified to serve on grand and  
14 petit juries unless he:

15 (1) is not a citizen of the United States,  
16 eighteen (18) years old, who is a bona fide reside  
17 of Guam."
