AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPHS (b) AND (c) OF SECTION 680.3 OF THE CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE AND TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (b) (1) OF SECTION 680.5 OF SAID CODE TO PERMIT PERSONS EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OF AGE TO SERVE ON JURIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subparagraphs (b) and (c) of Section 680.3 of
the Code of Civil Procedure are hereby amended to read as
follows:

"(b) Random selection from lists of registered voters. The Legislature finds that the lists of registere voters for the last general election in Guam represent a fair cross-section of the community of Guam.

The clerk shall make the random selection of names as follows: One out of every ten (10) names from such lis shall be selected by first selecting a starting number, by chance, between one and ten, and every tenth name thereafter shall be selected.

(c) Master jury wheel. The clerk shall maintain a master jury wheel for the territory. The names of all persons randomly selected from the voter registration lists shall be placed in the master jury wheel. Initially the master jury wheel shall be filled on or before Januar
