



AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SOUTH PACIFIC GAMES COMMISSION AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF SUCH COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1973, FOR THE OPERATION OF THE ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1972, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 WHEREAS, the South Pacific Games, which are held every
2 three (3) years in one of the member states or territories of
3 the South Pacific Commission, are worthy of public support since
4 such games encourage the development within the South Pacific
5 of strong cultural, political, and social bonds, and foster the
6 olympic ideals of good sportsmanship and unselfish dedication
7 to the pursuit of excellence; and

8 WHEREAS, the participation by the territory of Guam in the
9 last two South Pacific Games was of great value not only to the
10 Guam participants but to the territory at large, broadening
11 the knowledge of Guam and of its people held by other peoples
12 of the South Pacific; and

13 WHEREAS, the territory of Guam has been selected to host
14 the South Pacific Games for the year 1975; now therefore

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

16 Section 1. This Act shall be referred to as the "South
17 Pacific Games Commission Act."

18 Section 2. A South Pacific Games Commission is hereby
19 established, such Commission to consist of five (5) members,
20 including a Chairman, to be appointed by the Governor with the
21 advice and consent of the Legislature. The Commission is hereby
22 empowered and directed to act as spokesman for the people of

1 Guam in arranging the details attendant to the territory of
2 Guam's role as host for the 1975 South Pacific Games. Subject
3 to the availability of funds, the Commission shall have the
4 authority to enter into such contracts, to engage in such
5 programs and to hire such personnel, as are necessary to plan
6 for and conduct the 1975 South Pacific Games in the territory
7 of Guam.

8 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
9 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
10 sum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) for the
11 operation of the South Pacific Games Commission for the fiscal
12 year ending June 30, 1973, for the operation of the Eleventh
13 Guam Legislature for the calendar year ending December 31, 1972,
14 and for the purchase of equipment for the manufacture of
15 artificial limbs.

16 Section 4. The appropriation made by Section 3 of this
17 Act shall be apportioned as follows:

- 18 A. SOUTH PACIFIC GAMES COMMISSION
19 (Operations fiscal year ending
20 June 30, 1973.) \$35,000
- 21 B. ELEVENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE
22 (Payment of unused accrued annual
23 leave of employees of the Eleventh
24 Guam Legislature and for other purposes) 65,000
- 25 C. GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL
26 (For the purchase of equipment for the
27 manufacture of artificial limbs) 20,000.
