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AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER XIII TO TITLE X OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A GUAM ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. A new Chapter XIII is hereby added to Title X of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

## "CHAFTER XIII

Guam Environmental Protection Agency / Section 9970. Short title. This Act shall be known as the 'Guam Environmental Protection Agency Act'.

Section 9970.1. Statement of policy and purpose. It is hereby declared to be the public policy of this territory of Guam that a high quality environment be maintained at all times to guarantee an enjoyable life for all people at present and in the future, and that environmental degradation of the quality of land, water, and air by any pollutants, including all physical, chemical and biological agents, should not be allowed.

To these ends, it is the purpose of this Act to provide a united, integrated, and comprehensive territorywide program of environmental protection and to provide a framework to fulfill that task.

Section 9970.2. Guam Environmental Protection Agency. There is hereby created a Guam Environmental Protection Agency, hereinafter referred to as the 'Agency': The management of the Agency shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of nine (9) members to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature. Members of the Board shall serve for a period of three (3) years each, except that any momber appointed to fill a vacancy prior to the expiration of the term for which his predecessor was appointed, shall be appointed for the remainder of such term. The terms shall stagger so that three (3) members shall be appointed by the Covernor each year, except that in the year in which the law is enacted, the Governor shall appoint three (3) members for one (1) year; three (3) members for two (2) years, and three (3) members for three (3) years. The majority of the members of the Board shall not be employees of the government of Guam. A Chairman shall be elected from among the members.

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Members of the Board shall sorve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for reasonable travel and out-of-pocket expenses incurred in the performance of the Board duties.

Section 9970.3. Administration. (a) The Board shall appoint the Administrator of this Act, who shall not be a member of the Board. The Administrator shall have the responsibility for the administration of this Act under the supervision of the Board.

(b) The Board shall appoint a Deputy Administrator who shall not be a member of this Board. The Deputy Administrator shall perform such functions as the Administrator during the absence or disability of the Administrator, or in the event of a vacancy in the office of the Administrator.

(c) The Secretary of the Board shall be designated by the Administrator and approved by the Board. The Secretary shall be responsible for keeping records of meetings of, and actions by the Board.

Section 9970.4. Transfer of powers and duties to the

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Guam Environmental Protection Agency. (a) All functions vested by law in the Guam Water Pollution Control Commission pursuant to Chapter XI of Title X of the Government Code of Guam, and the Air Pollution Control Commission pursuant to Chapter XII of Title X of the Government Code of Guam, and the responsibilities of the Director of Public Health and Social Services in the above two Chapters, are hereby transferred to the Guam Environmental Protection Agency.

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(b) The functions vested in the Director of Public Health and Social Services pursuant to Subchapter R of Chapter VI of Title X of the Government Code of Guam in its entirety and Sections 9960.6, 9960.7 and 9660.12 of said Code, are hereby transferred to the Agency. (c) The functions vested in the Chief Officer of the Public Utility Agency of Guam and the Director of Public

Health and Social Services pursuant to Chapter V of Title XXII of the Government Code of Guam are hereby transferred to the Agency.

(d) The functions vested in the Director of Agriculture pursuant to Title LX and LXI of the Government Code of Guam are hereby transferred to the Agency.

Section 9970.5. Rules and Regulations. The Agency is hereby authorized and directed to adopt, amend and repeal rules and regulations implementing and consistent with the powers and duties vested in the Agency pursuant to Section 9970.4; provided, however, that no action taken with respect to such rules and regulations shall be effective unless such action is first presented to and approved by the Legislature. If, after ten (10) legislative days, the Legislature has not expressly approved or rejected such action, or any part thereof, by a resolution duly adopted by eleven (11) members of the Legislature, such

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action or any part thereof not expressly rejected shall be deemed to be approved.

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Section 9970.6. Abolishment of Water and Air Pollution Control Commissions. The Water Pollution Control Commission and the Air Pollution Commission, established pursuant to Chapter XI and Chapter XII of Title X of the Government Code of Guam are hereby abolished.

Section 9970.7. Assistance by governmental agencies. Office space and housekeeping functions shall be provided by the Department of Public Health and Social Services and other logistic support shall be provided by the Department of Administration. The services and facilities of departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of the government of Guam may be made available to the Agency in the exercise of its functions to the extent allowed by law.

Section 9970.8. Transfer of officers and employees. All officers and employees of the Water Pollution Control Cómmission, the Air Pollution Control Commission, Department of Public Health and Social Services, the Public Utility Agency of Guam, and the Department of Agriculture who have performed exclusively the functions transferred by Section 9970.4 of this Chapter shall be transferred to the Agency.

Section 9970.9. Transfer of assets, records and operational appropriations. The balance of all unexpended appropriations and all assets, property and records of the Guam Water Pollution Control Commission, the Air Pollution Control Commission, the Department of Public Health and Social Services, the Public Utility Agency of Guam, or the Department of Agriculture used or to be used for the functions transferred pursuant to Section 9970.4 of this Chapter shall be transferred to the Agency."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect ninety (90) days after its passage and approval.
