

Bill No. 639

Introduced by J. B. Butler

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (j) OF
SECTION 23100 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM TO PROVIDE THAT DRIVERS LICENSES
SHALL CONTAIN PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE LICENSEE
AND BE LAMINATED IN PLASTIC.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (j) of Section 23100 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(j) Every license and permit shall state whether
5 it is an operator's or chauffeur's license or instruction
6 permit and shall bear thereon the distinguishing number
7 assigned to the applicant, the date of expiration, the
8 name, the age and residence address of the licensee, a
9 brief description of such licensee for the purpose of
10 identification, his photograph in color or black and
11 white, and space for the signature of the licensee. In
12 the case of a chauffeur's license, the license shall also
13 state whether it is a general or restricted license,
14 and if restricted, the type of vehicle or combination
15 of vehicles the licensee is licensed to operate. Each
16 license and permit shall also contain a space for the
17 endorsement thereon of a record of each suspension or
18 revocation thereof. Upon receipt of a license or permit
19 the licensee or permittee shall write his usual signature
20 with pen and ink in the space provided on the license
21 or permit and such license or permit shall not be valid
22 until so signed. After signature the license shall be
23 laminated in plastic by the Department and returned
24 to the licensee."
