

Introduced by O. L. Delfin

AN ACT ADDING A SUBPARAGRAPH (c) TO SECTION 47100 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND ADDING A SECTION 47100.1 TO SAID CODE TO EMPOWER CUSTOMS OFFICERS TO MAKE ARRESTS OF CERTAIN PERSONS IMPORTING CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND TO AUTHORIZE REWARDS FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST AND CONVICTION OF SUCH PERSONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (c) is hereby added to Section  
3 47100 of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "(c) Any controlled substance appearing on Schedules  
5 I-V of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act of Chapter I,  
6 Title XV of the Penal Code; provided, however, any person  
7 who is registered or who is exempted from registering  
8 pursuant to said Uniform Controlled Substances Act, is  
9 not prohibited from importing any controlled substances  
10 with respect to which he is registered or exempted."

11 Section 2. Section 47100.1 is hereby added to the Government  
12 Code of Guam to read as follows:

13 "Section 47100.1. Enforcement of Section 47100(c);  
14 arrest; reward for information. (a) Any customs officer  
15 may:

16 (1) make arrests of persons who violate the  
17 prohibition contained in Subparagraph (c) of Section  
18 47100; and

19 (2) make seizures of any controlled substance  
20 imported into Guam in violation of Subparagraph (c)  
21 of Section 47100.

22 (b) The Director of Commerce is hereby authorized to  
23 award a reward of not more than One Thousand Dollars



1 (\$1,000) to any person who supplies to the Customs Officers  
2 information leading to the arrest and conviction of any  
3 person or persons who violate the prohibition contained in  
4 Subparagraph (c) of Section 47100. In determining the  
5 amount of such a reward, the Director shall give due con-  
6 sideration to the type and amount of the substance or  
7 substances involved in the violation."
