AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49007 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE
FEES TO BE CHARGED BY GUAM MEMORIAL
HOSPITAL.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 49007 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 49007. Fees. The Administrator is
5 authorized to establish a schedule of fees to be charged
6 for care and services at or by the hospital, subject to
7 the approval of the Board. No action may be taken by
8 the Administrator or by the government of Guam to enforce
9 payment of such fees unless the rules and policies for
10 abatements and discounts from such fees as authorized by
11 the provisions of Section 49008 of this Title, have been
12 duly and regularly adopted and promulgated pursuant to
13 the requirements of the Administrative Adjudication Law."
