AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4210 OF CHAPTER III,  
TITLE V, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE  
TO SERVICE RETIREMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4210 of Chapter III, Title V, Government  
3 Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4210. Retirement. Any member may retire  
5 on a service retirement annuity, upon his written appli-  
6 cation to and approval by the Board; provided that such  
7 member shall have attained at least sixty (60) years of age  
8 or fifty-five (55) years of age in the case of a member  
9 of the uniformed personnel and shall have completed at  
10 least ten (10) years of total service.

11 Any employee who has completed thirty (30) years of  
12 service may retire and shall be entitled to full retirement  
13 annuity.

14 Any employee or member, whether active or inactive,  
15 at his option may retire after twenty (20) years of  
16 service regardless of age. The retirement annuity for  
17 any employee or member described in this paragraph shall  
18 be reduced one-quarter (1/4) of one percent (1%) for  
19 each month such employee or member is under age sixty (60),  
20 from the amount determined for such employee or member  
21 as hereinafter provided."
